- Administer grass cutting and other landscaping services to medians and entrances.
- Pay utility bills.
- Make repairs to signs, lighting, flags, etc throughout the year.
- Post signs for City of Mobile Trash Pickup.
- Maintain good working relationship with City of Mobile officials.
- Administer Yard of the Month Award.
- Conduct annual dues drive.
- Publish annual newsletter.

Additionally, in 2023, the HOA would like to improve the Phaeton Drive entrance by putting it on a regular landscaping schedule. We would also like to also improve/replace the azaleas at the lower end of the Royal Carriage median. **These things can't happen without your monetary support!** 

It is time again to ask all of you for your 2023 dues payment. Our annual dues are only \$40 (many HOAs charge much higher than this). Your dues allow us to perform the above services, as well as other needed maintenance. **The proper upkeep of our entrances has a direct impact on everyone's property values**. We typically have only a 35% participation rate. **PLEASE** consider paying your dues this year, especially if you have not done so in the past.
